## **Dear Parish Community,**

In the spirit of transparency and accountability, I am pleased to present our annual financial report for the fiscal year from July 2023 to June 2024.

## **Gratitude for Your Generosity**

First and foremost, I want to express my deep gratitude and pride in the incredible generosity you, our parish family, have shown. Your commitment to sharing your Godgiven gifts of time, talent, and treasure has been the foundation for our parish's growth and the ongoing fulfillment of our mission.

## **Financial Highlights**

# 1. Offertory Collections

 Our offertory collections totaled \$1,027,402, marking a 1% increase over last year. However, collections over the past two years have remained largely flat and have not kept pace with rising operating expenses.

# 2. Operating Costs and Income

- Operating costs were \$43,701 above budget and increased by \$201,203 compared to the prior year, largely due to higher employee costs.
- Overall, our operating income was \$123,256, falling \$14,619 short of the budgeted amount.

## 3. Parish Financial Position

- Cash on hand at the end of June 2024 increased to \$2,447,303 from \$2,349,613 last year, of which \$1,094,795 is reserved for the church improvement and maintenance fund.
- We successfully reduced the Trinity Center debt by \$144,573, lowering the balance to \$2,144,573. The monthly second collection for debt reduction is on track to shorten the loan term, potentially moving the maturity date from 2039 to 2035.

## **Giving and Revenue Breakdown**

Our parish revenue sources this year include:

- Offertory: \$1,027,402 (54%)
- Gifts and Donations: \$358,000 (19%)
- Programs and Events: \$322,000 (17%)
- Other Income: \$184,000 (10%) Total Revenues: \$1,892,307

#### **Ministry Highlights**

Our parish is blessed to use your contributions to grow spiritually, deepen our faith, and serve others in the following ways:

- Celebrating the Eucharist together at nine weekend Masses and two weekday Masses, with an average Sunday attendance of 3,200.
- Nurturing the faith of **584 children** in religious education.
- Welcoming 92 baptisms, celebrating 161 First Communions, and strengthening 122 youth through Confirmation.
- Forming adults in faith, with **18 adults** completing the RCIA program.

- Supporting marriages (14 weddings) and providing spiritual comfort at 44 funerals.
- Assisting those in need through the Food Pantry and St. Vincent de Paul, which supports over 400 households weekly with groceries and utility or rent assistance.

## **Facility Improvement Projects**

Our parish has made significant strides in beautifying and updating our sacred spaces to enhance worship and fellowship:

## **Completed Projects:**

- Stained-glass windows installation: Completed at a total cost of \$376,000.
- Creation of a dedicated Adoration space at St. Ignatius Chapel.
- Installation of a prominent **Sacred Heart of Jesus Statue** in Trinity Center Plaza and the new **Marian Shrine**.

# **Ongoing and Upcoming Projects:**

- Vestibule Renovation and Restroom Expansion: This long-awaited project is currently pending permits from the City of San Jose, with an estimated cost of \$350,000.
- **Trinity Center Roof Maintenance**: Planned at a cost of \$100,000 to maintain the integrity of the building.
- Church HVAC System Installation: This installation is essential to address the heat inside the church and ensure year-round comfort for parishioners. Estimated cost: \$300,000.

#### **Financial Challenges**

As with many nonprofits, rising inflation and increasing utility and maintenance costs continue to impact our parish. We are currently striving to meet a weekly collection goal of **\$20,000** to support our operations.
